Self-Care Tips for Grievers

The weeks following a loved one's passing are challenging — with grief creeping to overtake you at any moment. Caring for your body, mind, and spirit is key to facing the future.

Here are a few other tips to remember:

- Establish a sleep hygiene schedule. Sleep, as simple as it sounds, is the first of many ways to lead to self-compassion and self-care.
- Lean on your family and friends. Take up offers of help, luncheon dates, or dinner. It benefits you as much as it benefits the giver, who desires to show their love and concern for you. Be careful not to overdo it; it's important to find the right balance and be able to say "no."


